REGULATING WATER METER TAMPERING  
ORDINANCE # B.V.-08

ARTICLE ONE: General Provisions

Section 1. (A).

All rules and regulations contained herein, together with such amendments as may be hereafter adopted, are hereby designated as the ORDINANCE REGULATING WATER METER TAMPERING. hereinafter referred to as the ordinance

ARTICLE TWO. Definition:

No person shall tamper with or bypass a water meter in the Barton Village Water System.

ARTICLE THREE. Penalty:

A person found violating this ordinance shall be fined Two-Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) for the use of the Village and shall be liable for damages resulting from a violation of this ordinance to be recovered in any action on the case

ARTICLE FOUR. ORDINANCE IN FORCE:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect sixty (60) days from the date of its adoption unless a petition is filed in accordance with Title 24, Section 1973, Vermont Statutes Annotated in which case the effective date shall be as governed by Title 24, Section 1973(e), Vermont Statutes Annotated.

Section 1. (A).

In accordance with the provisions of Title 24, Section 1973, Vermont Statutes Annotated, an ordinance adopted by a municipality may be disapproved by a vote of a majority of the qualified voters of the municipality voting on the question at an annual meeting or special meeting duly warned for the purpose, pursuant to petition signed by not less than five per cent (5%) of the qualified voters of the municipality and presented to the legislative body or the clerk of the municipality within forty-four (44) days following the date of adoption of the ordinance by the legislative body.

The within and foregoing Ordinance was adopted pursuant to law by the Trustees of the Village of Barton on the 1st day of May, 1998.
