Winter Parking Ban

(November 1st- April 1st)

Parking is allowed over night on Village Streets except when the DPW Foreman calls for a **Winter Parking Ban** due to weather or snow removal activities (Village Parking Ordinance.) When a Winter Parking Ban is in effect parking will be prohibited between the hours of 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM on all Village Streets.

When will a Winter Parking Ban be declared?

A winter parking ban will be in effect from November 1st through April 1st annually.

What if I don't move my car?

Your car may be ticketed and towed to allow Public Works staff to plow or salt the roads. Failure to move your car may result in towing charges as well as a \$35.00 penalty.

How will I know a Winter Parking Ban is in effect?

Where can I park during a Winter Parking Ban?

Residents may park on Lake Street, Church Street and Glover Street **only** between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM, as defined below.

- Church Street (VT16): 200 feet from the Intersection of Village Common to Main Street (U.S. Route 5)
- Main Street: 800 feet from School Street to Village Common
- Main Street: 150 feet from West Street to Water Street
