Pageant Park Campground & Park Policies

Welcome, to Pageant Park Campground and Crystal Lake. We are a very small campground and take pride in our small unique park. We want you to enjoy your stay here but we do have a few simple and easy policies that must be followed.

If you are asked to leave you will not receive a refund

NO LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY!

The park opens at 9am and closes at 9pm for day use as well as camper guests. All day users and camper guests need to leave the campground & Park by 9pm.

Campground quiet time is from 10PM to 8AM.

- **1.** No alcoholic beverages on the beach or on display for others to view. We recommend PLASTIC or other beverage containers as no glass containers are allowed on the lawn areas or beach.
- **2.** We will not tolerate any disrespectful behavior. If there are any outward signs of intoxication or drug use that disrupts the peace of the campers or other day visitors you will be asked to leave. Please be considerate of the campers beside you and if young children are close by. We are a small campground & park. Voices carry.
- **3.** No firearms and explosive devices.
- **4.** No soliciting.
- **5.** No fishing or boats of any kind are allowed in the swimming area. That area is just for swimmers.
- **6.** No **motorized** boats can be launched from Pageant Park of ANY kind. You must use the boat launch at the south end of the lake. You can then moor your boat near the Pageant Beach area.
- 7. NO ATVs are allowed on the lawn area or on the beach.
- **8.** No fires outside of fireplaces or grills.- This also means no fires on the beach. If you start a fire please ensure it is OUT before leaving the park or walking away from it for a period of time. Same goes for charcoal grills. BE RESPONSIBLE.
- **9.** Pets are allowed. But please keep them on a leash and controlled at all times. If you leave the campground you must take your pet unless they are safe and comfortable (cool) in your RV. They must not be left tied up outside if you are not present. Also, **please pick up after your pet.** No one likes to step in dog poop. Please be a responsible pet owner.

- 10.Do not cut trees or branches down in the park to use as firewood. Do not strip bark off trees. Do not steal wood from other campers. If any of these things take place, you will be asked to leave.
- 11. Any satellite dishes and antennas must be attached to trailers and not to trees or meter posts.
- 12. No burning of trash, only unpainted, untreated wood and or paper.
- 13. Seasonal Decks should be limited to 6' by 8'. And moved at the end of the season.
- 14. Household furniture (sofa's and recliners) and kitchen appliances (large refrigerators) will not be permitted.

PARKING: Each Seasonal Camp Site is limited to TWO vehicles. You cannot block in another car. Guests are to park in overflow parking or OUTSIDE of the park. If you have a commercial vehicle you will be asked to park outside of the park. If you have a boat trailer you will be asked to park that outside the park. This is a SMALL campground. Please be considerate of your neighbor's spaces.

Specific for Seasonal Campers

Guests to your site are welcomed, but they <u>must pay</u> to get into the park just as anyone else would have to. We recommend you purchase a punch card or a Family seasons pass if you expect a lot of visitors.
