

Barton Village is seeking a Caretaker(s) for the 2024 Pageant Park camping season!

Do you like camping? Do you like being paid to camp? If you'd like to be paid to camp along Crystal Lake's picturesque shores, the Pageant Park Caretaker(s) position may be the job for you!

Caretaker(s) Responsibilities:

- Maintain gate admissions.
- Maintain schedule of campsite bookings.
- Enforce Park rules. Rules should be posted by the gate and provided to overnight campers.
- Contact Village employees about issues or questions regarding the maintenance and/or management of the Park.
- Contact Vermont State Police for violations other than Park rules (destruction of Park property, disturbances that caretakers cannot control, etc.)
- Maintain bathhouse – Requires a thorough cleaning each morning, and periodic checks throughout the day to ensure cleanliness.
- Maintain beach area – Rake and clean as needed to maintain beach cleanliness (note: glass is a particular concern as buried glass may work itself up to the surface)
- Clean ashes from grills daily.
- Pick up litter as needed.
- Assist Village employees with installation of water flags, tether ball, horseshoes, etc.
- Maintain records of any equipment loaned to campers.

Caretaker(s) will be responsible for ensuring a responsible individual is on site to assume their duties in the event of their absence.

The DPW Foreman will oversee the overall management of the Park in conjunction with the caretakers. Periodic visits will be made to assure that the Park continues to operate in a safe and attractive manner.

Barton Village shall pay a fee in the amount of \$489 per week for the services provided by the Caretaker(s) as well as provide one free camping space.
