The legal voters of the Village of Barton, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet at the Barton Village Memorial Building, 17 Village Square in Barton, Vermont, on Thursday, February 12, 2026, between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00) in the forenoon (a.m.), at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00) in the afternoon (p.m.), at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot upon the following Article of business:

### ARTICLE I


Shall general obligation bonds or notes in an amount not to exceed Ten Million Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$10,870,000), subject to reduction by the application of federal and state grants-in-aid and reserve funds, be issued for the purpose of constructing wastewater system improvements including upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Facility and Main Pump Station, the estimated cost of such improvements being Ten Million Eight Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$10,870,000)?


